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Overview.

This Bye-Law was discussed at the Interim Committees June 12th 2007 meeting and formally adopted without challenge. It is based on the concerns of the Interim Committee with regard to the protection of the Clubs retail interests and those of it's appointed sub-contractors alongside any attempt by Minors to circumnavigate the Club Bye-law with regards to minors consuming Alcoholic Beverages within Bahrain RFC's premises.

Notice to Members.

A Notice to members shall be sent via e-mail to all Bahrain RFC Members stating the following;

Restrictions on Members and Non-Members bringing outside Food and/or Beverages in to the BRFC Premises.

It has been brought to the Committees attention that a number of members and non-members are bringing their own Food and Beverages in to the Club Premises. Members are reminded that sales from the Club's Food and Beverage outlets contribute considerably to the Finances of the Club as a whole.

It has also been noted that a number of minors are bringing Alcoholic Beverages (mainly spirits) and purchasing soft drinks from the bar before consuming the resultant cocktails within the Club's premises. This is strictly illegal!

Therefore Members and Non-Members are not allowed to bring Food or Beverages in to Bahrain RFC without prior permission from the Club's Executive Committee.

We would like to thank members for their cooperation in regard to this notice, and their assistance in safeguarding the interests of the Club and of other Club Members.

This Notice is to be sent out periodically, & to be displayed in the Reception Area of the Club.



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Notice to be Posted in Reception.

1) *Displayed on Notice Board near Entrance.*

Notices to Staff Members.

Notices and Instructions to Bahrain RFC Security Staff & Club Receptionists.

- 1) Bahrain RFC Security Personnel & Receptionists must read this Bye-Law and sign to state that they fully understand it prior to working inside the Club.
- 2) If you see a member of the club or member's guest attempting to enter the Club with their own food or Beverage products you should point out the sign displayed in reception and ask the person or person(s) involved to leave the products either in their vehicle or in the care of Reception.
- 3) If you see a minor in possession of any alcohol please challenge them as per the Bye-law on the consumption of Alcohol.
- 4) If a member refuses to cooperate with you, or is persistently in violation of this rule you should report them to the Club's Executive Committee or Management for further action.

(You have the backing of the Club, and the Law to refuse. There will be no comeback if you follow these rules, ONLY IF YOU DO NOT!)



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Instructions to all Bahrain RFC Management and Executive Committee Members.

It is important that we totally back the Staff in the enforcement of this bye-law, only by empowering them can we hope to have it properly enforced.

In the event that a mistake is made, please do not chastise the Staff member in public as this will undermine both their confidence and their authority in front of members.
